Goals 2012-13

Student Learning Goals:

Mathematics: By Spring 2014, student learning in the area mathematics will increase so that each school will score 4 out of 5 in growth and a 5/5 in achievement based on Star calculations. In addition, 65% of juniors will score at or above the college placement readiness score in math.

Reading: By Spring 2014, student learning in the area reading will increase so that each school will score 4 out of 5 in growth and a 5/5 in achievement based on Star calculations. In addition, 75% of juniors will score at or above the college placement readiness score in Reading.

Language usage/Writing: By Spring 2014, student learning in the area writing/Language usage will increase so that each school will score 4 out of 5 in growth and a 5/5 in achievement based on Star calculations. In addition, 75% of juniors will score at or above the college placement readiness score in writing.

Strategies to achieve these goals include:

- Implementation of teaching strategies that activate learning and engage students.
- Development of collaboration skills (2012-13) and implementation of focused collaborative teaming within the school day (2013-14).
- Implementation of Common Core State Standards
- Audit of and learning regarding best practices in 504 and IDEA
- Continuation of data use to inform instruction and intervention
- Celebration of actions that lead to district vision
- Communication and parent/community participation that promotes the district throughout the year.
